Disaster Success!!

"Disaster Success" may seem like a strange title for a newsletter article, however that is what we experienced at Carmel Manor on April 24th and 25th. You may have noticed our parking lot marked off with yellow caution tape and construction cones, or staff members walking or being transported looking like the walking wounded. You may have heard announcements of CODE EASY over the PA system or by bullhorn from the command station or observed staff members lying in odd places waiting to be rescued. This is all part of what we need to do to be prepared for any natural disaster that may occur.

Carmel Manor conducted a Mock
Disaster Drill and Evacuation to practice what we have been taught and put
into action our ability to keep our residents safe in the event of a natural (or
unnatural) disaster. Staff were assigned
roles of victim or rescuer and were quite
realistic in their portrayal of each as we
moved to evacuate the building. Our
scenario was that of a fictitious "plane
crash" into the building with various

exits blocked by fire or debris necessitating staff taking an alternate route to safety. Through each evacuation we noted what we did best and what may need to be adjusted moving forward. There were very few adjustments that needed to be made which speaks to the training and ability of our staff in their care for our residents. All departments participated and were willing to do whatever it takes to keep our residents safe.

Events such as this do not just happen, and we are very proud of all the planning and preparation that went into this disaster drill. We are also very proud of all our staff whose care, concern, and willingness to go above and beyond make Carmel Manor the true "home" that it is.


One quilt top is made from 3 yds of cotton fabric.




